Agreement with Air Force: Three (3) active duty volunteers with known heavy exposure be included for fat biopsy and follow-up. Travel fund citation and invitational orders to be provided by VACO R & D.

To be scheduled at VA Hines week of March 19-23 if committee approvals pass.

Dr. Gross fat assay laboratory is ready for specimens.
Hospitals will send specimens without identification of patient as study or control.

At one participating hospital a potential volunteer has indicated legal advice <u>not</u> to participate in the fat assay study for fear of jeopardizing his own opportunity for compensation, and the class action suit pending against herbicide manufacturers.
