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## What To Do With Found U.S. Military Items

- 1. Found U.S. military items remain the property of the United States Government and the Department of Defense as official custodian.
- 2. Found military items should not be retained by the finder who is seeking, for whatever reason, to make personal contact with the GI who lost the item, or a member of the GI's family. By law found military items must be mailed immediately to:

Secretary of Defense Room 3E880 The Pentagon Washington DC 20301

- 3. The Dept of Defense has many resources at its disposal to return lost items.
- 4. The finder should include a letter (or the completed form, below) describing the place and circumstances in which the item was found, and contact information for DoD investigators, or the GI, or his/her family members:
