MESSAGE CA SENATORS & CONGRESSMAN NO TO AMNESTY OR IMMIGRATION REFORM-11-07-14:

Message text follows:

Dear Representative Calvert:

A poll conducted during Tuesday's elections shows that three-quarters of voters oppose efforts by President Obama to bypass Congress and take executive actions on immigration. Furthermore, 80% of voters believe that new jobs should go to Americans and legal immigrants already in the U.S. Please urge the White House not to take action on immigration as 74% of American voters oppose President Obama going it alone on this issue.

The voters have spoken, and they overwhelmingly oppose Pres. Obama's plan to take executive action on amnesty. The poll by The Polling Company/WomanTrend asked voters if they prefer Pres. Obama working with Congress or acting on his own, and they chose Pres. Obama working with Congress by a 3-to-1 margin.

Unfortunately, Pres. Obama made it clear yesterday that he plans on moving forward with an executive action that would issue work permits to millions of illegal aliens. The President said "what I'm not going to do is just wait."

Millions of jobless Americans and legal immigrants already living in the country are counting on you to do the right thing. By giving work permits to millions of illegal aliens, it only creates more competition for jobs and depresses wages.

I urge you to tell the White House not to act on immigration since only 20% of voters approve of his executive action.

We do NOT need Amnesty, nor do we need Immigration Reform, Just ENFORCE THE LAWS WE HAVE!
