SUBECT : Quail Run, Missouri, Dixoin Study Briefing

On Thursday, April 17, 1986, Dr. Barry Johnson of the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) and Dr. Henry Falk of CDC's Center for Environmental Health (CEH) will hold a pre-publication briefing on the results of a study of persons who were exposed to dioxin-contaminated waste oil that was sprayed on a dirt road at the Quail Run Mobile Home Park in Gray Summit, Missouri, in 1971. AOWG members and others, including representatives from the Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Justice are invited to attend the briefing.

The Quail Run study was conducted by CEH in cooperation with ATSDR, under the Department's Superfund authorities. Results are scheduled for publication in the <u>Journal of the American Medical Association</u> and in CDC's <u>Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report on Friday</u>, April 18, 1986.

The briefing will be held at 10:30 a.m. in the Secretary's Conference Room (Stonehenge). Please come to the Sixth Floor Reception area of the Hubert H. Humphrey Building, 200 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C.
