THE DOD HAS DIRECTED AN IN-DEPTH STUDY TO DETERMINE THE MILITARY BENEFITS OF THE SEASIA HERBICIDE PROGRAM. THE U.S. ARMY'S ENGINEER STRATEGIC STUDIES GROUP (ESSG), WITH AIR FORCE PARTICIPATION, IS CONDUCTING THE STUDY. PART OF THE STUDY EFFORT WILL INVOLVE A SURVEY OF PERSONNEL FROM ALL SERVICES WHO CAME IN CONTACT WITH THE HERBICIDE PROGRAM.
