DEDRUMMING

1. Dedrum into new drum only contents of one drum.
2. Mark new drums same as old including sequence number (TCN Number, Sequence Number, any other sample numbers).
3. Empty old drums as much as possible and close bungs.
4. Store empty drums in separate locations with leak (or potential leak) source up and drum in a horizontal position.
5. Store in sequence number lots two drums high with access at both ends-fork truck width between rows at bung end.
6. Pick-up any spills with "oil absorb" and put used "oil absorb" in deheaded drum for later disposal in landfill.
7. Keep daily log of:
 - a. Drums moved.
 - b. Drums redrummed and reason for redrumming.
 - c. Report log in weekly report to SA-ALC/DS & AFLC/DS.
 - d. Weekly report should also include any significant events.

REFS: A. TELECON, 22 SEP 76, BETWEEN CAPTAIN J. T. TAYLOR, USN, NCBC/CODE 10, AND MR. S. P. HEATON, AFLC/LOTMT.

B. TELECONS, 22 SEP 76, BETWEEN COL G. TAYLOR, EHL/K, MAJOR C. THALKEN, USAF ACADEMY/DFCB, AND MR. S. P. HEATON, AFLC/LOTMT.

1. REF A CONCERNED NCBC POST DISPOSITION OF HERBICIDE ORANGE PLANS WHICH INCLUDE THE CONSTRUCTION (MCP) OF AN EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE FACILITY IN THE IMMEDIATE STORAGE SITE AREA. THIS MCP IS APPROVED/FUNDED AND GROUND BREAKING IS DESIRED AS EARLY

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IN CY 1977 AS POSSIBLE. CONSEQUENTLY, NCBC NEEDS TO BE ASSURED THAT NO ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS RESULTING FROM STORAGE/DISPOSITION OF HERBICIDE ORANGE WILL DELAY OR POSSIBLY HALT CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS.

2. FOR EHL/K AND USAFA. REF B OUTLINED REF A DISCUSSION AND CONFIRMED PREVIOUS DIALOGUE BETWEEN EHL/K AND NCBC/CODE 10. IT IS THEREFORE REQUESTED THAT CONCERTED ACTIONS BE TAKEN TO ASSURE THAT EXISTING OR PROJECTED ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS, IF ANY, ARE IDENTIFIED AND THAT CORRECTIVE MEASURES ARE PRESCRIBED, TAKEN OR SCHEDULED TO COMMENCE AS SOON AS PRACTICAL. THE RESOURCES OF WRIGHT STATE UNIVERSITY (WSU) SHOULD ALSO BE UTILIZED TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT UNDER THE CURRENT CONTRACT AND SHOULD COMMENCE CONCURRENT WITH YOUR EFFORTS. THERE ARE PRESENTLY 10-12 BIOLOGICAL SAMPLES FROM NCBC AT WSU WHICH WERE TAKEN JAN 1976 BY USAFA/DFCB. THESE SHOULD BE ANALYZED WITHOUT DELAY. UNFORTUNATELY, WSU ADVISES THAT A REPRESENTATIVE OF SA-ALC/PPZM TOLD THEM THEY WERE NOT CONTRACTUALLY COVERED FROM MIDNIGHT 15 SEP 76 THROUGH 30 SEP 76. REFERENCE AFLC/LOS MSGS 141200Z JULY 76 AND 092040Z SEP 76, ALSO AFLC/LOT MSG 191510Z AUG 76.

3. FOR SA-ALC. IT IS CONSIDERED IMPERATIVE THAT ACTION BE TAKEN

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TO AVOID FURTHER SLIPPAGE OF WSU CONTRACTUAL COVERAGE BEYOND 1 OCT 1976. YOUR FY 1977 INITIAL FUNDING DOCUMENT FOR HERBICIDE ORANGE PROGRAM SUPPORT EXPENSES WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING O&M PEC 7-11-11 FUNDS:

A. USAF ACADEMY DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY/BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES/DFCB (\$20,000 - EEIC 586).

B. NAVAL CONSTRUCTION BATTALION CENTER GULFPORT MS (\$40,000 -

EEIC 586).

C. USAF OCCUPATIONAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH LABORATORY OPERATING LOCATION KELLY AFB TX OF THE AEROSPACE MEDICAL DIVISION (AFSC) BROOKS AFB TX (\$75,000 - EEIC 586). THIS WAS FORMERLY USAF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH LABORATORY (AFLC) KELLY AFB TX. CHANGE IS EFFECTIVE 1 OCT 76.
